## Teacher Scholarships

The Maryland Coastal Bays Program has established three scholarships to assist teachers who wish to attend the Maryland Association for Environmental and Outdoor Education's 33<sup>rd</sup> Annual Conference. The conference will be held at the Princess Royale in Ocean City, MD from February 1-4, 2018. The scholarship program will encourage local teachers to broaden their environmental education knowledge, network with passionate Marylanders, and to create, investigate, and receive resources to bring back to their classrooms. Scholarship: Worth up to \$330

- Each recipient receives one Standard Conference Registration; includes Friday Opening & Keynote, Exhibit Hall Reception, Saturday Breakfast, All Saturday Sessions, Saturday Lunch, Silent Auction, and Saturday Night Social (\$150 value)
- Note: Additional Thursday/Friday/Sunday Workshops can be added, but not to surpass \$140. Please outline these on your application form. If you wish to register for the conference with the Friday workshops included, please state this in the form. This conference registration will cost \$225. - Each recipient receives a one-year individual membership to MAEOE. A membership provides you with exclusive discounts throughout the year on certifications and workshops (\$40 value)
- MCBP will register the scholarship recipients for: the Standard Registration, one-year membership, and any other workshops, totaling no more than \$330. This registration will be completed by January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

### Criteria

- Teachers must be from public or private schools found within the Coastal Bays watershed (Worcester County, Maryland).
- Teachers of all disciplines are eligible.
- Submit a 300-word narrative regarding the importance of environmental education in and out of the classroom and how you incorporate it into lessons and service projects.
- Be willing to write a 100-word reflection following the conference. Due March 2 to the e-mail below.
